Roman Yearly Calendar at sunset. Yahuah/אָפּאָז Elohims days start at sunset as in the above
Scriptural reference in Creation on His calendar as when He gave to Mosheh on Mount Sinai
for the Hebrew people in Wayyiqra/Leviticus 27:34**

FIRST MOON OF THE YEAR: The NEW MOON starts at ZERO—the DARK MOON--when it is perfectly
centered between the Earth and the sun disc.
